## EAYF Minor Division Championship Game

***Bills vanquish Cowboys:*** The Bills captured the EAYF Minot Division Super Bowl Championship with a 26 – 12 win over the Cowboys. The Bills avenged their only blemish of the season over the Cowboys who had just a week ago upset last season’s champions the Rams. The Bills broke open a tie ball game in the second quarter behind a dominating performance by its offensive line that enabled Cade Bruington to gallop for touchdown runs of 59, 58, 49, and 52 yards. Bruington set a EAYF Minor Division Super Bowl record with 253 total rushing yards. The Cowboys offensive threat, Jacob Hobbs was held in check most of the game by an aggressive defense. While Hobbs was able to score on a 55-yard run that tied the score in the first quarter, the Bills controlled the line of scrimmage that stymied the Cowboys effort until late in the fourth quarter when Hobbs broke loose and scored on a 52 yard run with little over a minute remaining in the game.

## EAYF Junior Varsity Division Championship Game

**Buccaneers Overpower Titans:** The Buccaneers raced to an early lead and controlled all aspects of the game to claim the EAYF Junior Varsity crown. The Titans entered the game a clear favorite especially after their impressive win over the Bucs a month earlier by a score of 7-0. However, the Titans faced a stifling Buccaneer defense and time-consuming offense attack that negated their size advantage. Jacob Fiepke 18 yard scamper around their right end, and Caleb Humphrey's 1-point conversion run put the Buccaneers ahead by a score of 7-0, which proved to be the only points the Bucs needed for victory. Defense and ball control contributed to the Bucs success. A stifling Bucs defense led by Carson McCann, Shane Oberdorf, Edwin Martin, Riley Collins, Logan Greenwell, and Isaiah Sublett grounded the Titans offensive juggernaut limiting them to only a total of 41 yards rushing. The Bucs offense line controlled the line of scrimmage enabling Jack Sheppard to rack up 114 yards rushing which limited the Titans powerful offense machine from taking the field. In the fourth quarter, the Buccaneers solidified its lead when Jacob Fiepke scored on a 14 yard run around the left end. Any hope of a comeback was quickly erased when Paul Fiepke recovered a Titans fumble on the ensuing kickoff that enabled the Buccaneers offensive machine to run out the clock.

## EAYF Varsity Division Championship Game

**Cowboys Capitalize on Chargers Miscues:** The Cowboys became back-to-back Varsity Division Super Champs by breaking open a tie ball game in the third quarter by scoring 28 unanswered points, and rolled to a 42-12 win over the upstart Chargers. The Chargers held the Cowboys at bay throughout much of the first half and early third quarter. The Cowboys scored first with a five-yard run by Dalton Parr yet the Chargers answered back with a two yard run by Colin Fulkerson (the e first time all year the Cowboys allowed a score in the first half). The Cowboys scored late in the second quarter on a five yard run by Jack Wilson and a successful two-point conversion and took a 14 – 6 lead at the end of the first half. The Chargers electrified the crowd at the start of the third quarter with a 67-yard touchdown pass from Hunter Sullivan to Jake Yates. A successful two-point conversion knotted the score at 14-14. The Cowboys though where undeterred. Kevin Adkins setup the Cowboys deep in Chargers territory with a 50 yard kick off return. Mason Bryan then scored on a 30-yard run, which stemmed the tide and enabled the Cowboys to take control of the game. Special teams play by the Chargers became their Achilles heel. The Cowboys scored their 20 points on Chargers miscues during the ensuing kickoffs. Those points where the result of two 25 yard runs by Mason Bryan and a 12 yard run by Kevin Adkins and a successful two point conversion by Peyton Payne.
